Getting back into the swing of things is taking it's toll and I am sure this is leading to sleepy children and early nights.

A special welcome goes to our Kindergarten students who embark on the very beginning of their educational journey and we would also like to welcome our new students and families into our school and community. I know together we will all wrap around them and make them feel welcome.

We unexpectedly said goodbye to Ian and Sharon, our cleaners over the holidays and we thank them for their contributions to school, wishing them all the very best for their next endeavours.

As you can see by our term planner we have a very busy term ahead with 2 weeks of swimming lessons, our first assembly for the term, followed by various sporting clinics and carnivals. We ease our way into the second half of a short term with a public holiday, where students will receive an extra day whilst staff have a School Development Day on the Tuesday. After the first assembly, classrooms will be opened for class meetings and I would encourage you all to try to get into your child's class to gain a better understanding of the expectations and routines for the year.

As you are aware, LGDHS has implemented the new Uniform Policy for 2024, by now you should have received a copy. This policy has been endorsed by the School Board and is being enforced with students. I have invited our local police to attend the school at the beginning and end of the day to enforce the importance of wearing helmets and abiding by the road rules. I have made a point of being out at the bike racks during these times and have noticed several students not wearing helmets and riding down the middle of the street upon arrival and departure. I strongly encourage you to talk with your child about the importance of their safety.

I would like to welcome our new Sergeant to town Mr Wade Bambling, the school looks forward to working with our local police force in supporting the children of our close knit community.

Message from the School Health Nurse: Laura Ballard

Welcome to the new school year. My name is Laura Ballard and I am the School Health Nurse who visits your school.

School Health Nurses work in schools to promote healthy development and wellbeing so students may reach their full potential. A major part of my work is focused on early intervention and the School Entry Health Assessment program. Additionally, the nurse can be contacted at any time throughout primary school if you have concerns about your child's health, development, or wellbeing.

School Health Nurses are skilled in assessing adolescent health needs. We engage in health counselling with young people to identify issues, risks, and protective factors, provide advice and brief intervention, assist with access and referral to other services, and provide follow up care. Young people can drop into the health center or make appointments to discuss health and wellbeing issues

School Health Nurses serve as a health contact point for children and their families, providing information, assessment, health counselling and referral. They also work in partnership with schools to support teachers in health-related curriculum and can assist in the development of health care plans for students with complex and chronic health needs.

The services provided are free and confidential.


IN THE KITCHEN

- Ask kids to help look for products with the most stars










IN THE GARDEN




