

A Peek into Year 6 with Miss Corps

A Peek in to Yean b with Miss Corps

This term in Year 6 art, students have been studying Bernadette Twomey's abstract botanical artworks. They have identified colour palettes and the variety of shapes and details used to inspire their own works filled with flowers, leaves, and plants, as well as small details in the negative space. Students have used these visual conventions and visual arts practices to express their own ideas, themes, and concepts in their artworks.

During art lessons, students explored how ideas are expressed in artworks from different contemporary, historical, and cultural contexts. They have compared Twomey's work, a 21st-century Australian botanical artist, with that of Ellis Rowan, a 20th-century Australian botanical illustrator. This comparison has helped students learn and identify the different historical contexts and ideas of each artist.

Similarly, in History this term, we are comparing the daily lives of individuals in the 20th century to those in the 21st century. Students have completed a T-chart in pairs to show their understanding.





Message from P&C President: Nikki Lewis


Dear Lake Grace Community,


Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease

This is a common, acute, viral infection. Symptoms include fever, sore throat, blisters in the mouth and on the hands and feet. There is no specific treatment for hand, foot and mouth disease, only treatment to relieve symptoms, with use of paracetamol or ibuprofen. It mainly affects children under the age of 10 but can also affect adolescents. It spreads easily from one person to another via airborne or droplet contact with infected person; via direct or indirect contact with the fluid from blisters; or via contact with infected persons faeces.

Symptoms usually last 3-7 days but a person will remain infectious as long as there is **fluid in the blisters**. Therefore, should remain home from school until **all blisters have formed crusts that are dry**.

To minimise the spread of Hand, foot and mouth;

Wash hands thoroughly, specially after using the toilet or assisting children in the toilet. Make sure your child isn't sharing drink bottles, cutlery, towels, toothbrushes or clothing. Keep your child home until all the fluid in their blisters have dried.
