- Social Development: Students build empathy and strong interpersonal skills in a supportive community.
- Flexible Grouping: Diverse ages and abilities enable effective differentiation and teamwork.
- Continuous Progression: Students advance as they are ready, beyond traditional grade boundaries.
- Strong Relationships: Teachers work with students for multiple years, deepening understanding and support.

We believe this approach prepares students for lifelong success and we thank you for your support!

This Term we have a few new and returning faces in our staffing cohort which is very exciting to see. We would like to welcome Carey Higgins as a Highschool EA and returning EA's Joely Slinn also in Highschool and Charlee Garlick in lower primary.

Over the school holidays our school got a little pampering with new glass doors at each entrance and a much need upgrade to our accessibility parking and entrance.


The Lake Grace Community Library received some new chairs also, which will make it a more comfortable space for students to enjoy sitting to read their books.

We look forward to a great year ahead and can't wait to see the progress each student makes throughout the year.


